The foundation was established by the generosity of our late benefactors, Mr. & Mrs. Yohachiro Iwasaki, and the initiative of Rockhampton businessman, the late Mr. Les Duthie, for the purposes of providing subsidized, Motel-style, week long (approximately) Holidays for needy persons including the disabled, infirm and aged, and is under strict control of a Board of Governors, including 6 Australian and 3 Japanese members, one being the grandson of Mr & Mrs Iwasaki. The son, Mr Fukuso Iwasaki, has recently retired.

The Subsidised Holiday Scheme with the assistance of the Management of Bayview Tower in Yeppoon, since May 2008, have been accommodating and assisting our guests to enjoy a most memorable and fun filled holiday.

To provide these holidays, Bayview Tower Resort situated in the Heart of Yeppoon, has been made available to the Iwasaki Foundation. Bayview Tower Resort is situated on the beachfront, with access to shops, restaurants, public transport, clubs, etc. It is the Iwasaki Foundation's pleasure to be able to offer to its Special guests the benefits of such an environment, which might otherwise be denied them.

ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible for a subsidised holiday, guests with the aged pension, the waiting period is three years, for "needy", and disabled persons and carers the waiting period is one year. Eligibility is dependent on the views of the Board of Directors.

ACCOMMODATION: We have available 15 only twin share rooms, therefore our final number of guests would be 30 guests per week. The Foundation will offer to twin share only and no single requests can be accepted. If in the circumstance of Carer and recipient and/or family requests requiring separate rooms a small number of family rooms are available at the IFL management's discretion and Bayview Tower availability.

MEALS. Cost includes three meals a day. Most special diets can be accommodated, but notice must be given in advance. Please seek advice on application.

WHEEL CHAIR ACCESS. The motel has three wheel chair accessible rooms, which include shower and toilet wheel / chair access, and grab rails.

UNITS. We have access to fifteen, twin share units, three of which we have mentioned, are wheel chair accessible. All units have reverse cycle air conditioning, en suite facilities, TV, coffee and tea making, a standard sized refrigerator, as some guests require special dietary needs, which are not available at the motel.

BVT is situated on the beach front in a very accessible area of Yeppoon. Shops, buses, wheelchair access to beach and facilities, and tours as were made available at Motel Melaleuca will also be made available to our guests. All rooms have a beautiful view of the beach and surrounds.

Tours offered include:
Footlights Theatre Restaurant, WaterPark Eco Tour, Ferns Hideaway Heritage Village, The Caves, and More.

Arrival time: SUNDAY from 1.30pm. (Non train travellers)

Departure time: SATURDAY until 10am. (Non train travellers).

If you are travelling up to Rockhampton by Tilt Train (ETA Rockhampton 6.30 – 6.45 pm Sunday,) using your rail passes, we will organise bus transfers per YOUNG'S BUS SERVICE to and from the Resort for an approximate cost of \$13.40 per person return.

FUNDING ASSISTANCE:

Not only will the Iwasaki Foundation Ltd be re-introducing the Holiday Scheme, but due to the diversification of the Foundation, the Foundation will now be giving consideration to applicants upon request, for the provision of a Grant for funding assistance of "welfare" projects of eligible persons/groups.

If your organisation considers it is eligible because it provides for the welfare of aged, infirm, disabled or needy persons and requires funding to better provide such welfare, it is invited to apply to the Foundation for an application form. This application will be reviewed by the Board of Governors and consideration will be given on their relative merits and Iwasaki Foundation Ltd. funding available.
